1. Who is your favorite character and why?
2. Was there a character you did not like? Who and why?
3. What motivated Enid? Why do she do what she did? Were her actions justified?
4. How has the past shaped the characters' lives?
5. Do any of the characters remind you of people you know?
6. Which character do you most closely identify with or relate to? (even if you don't like the character)
7. If you could smack any of the characters upside the head, who would it be and why?
8. How do characters change or evolve throughout the course of the story? What events trigger such changes?
9. What was unique about the setting of the book? Did it enhance or take away from the story?
10. What was the most pivotal scene in the book? Why?
11. Which other scenes resonated with you personally in either a positive or negative way? Why?
12. What main ideas—themes—does the story explore?
13. Was there a particular comment or insight in the book that stuck with you? Why?
14. Were there any notable racial, cultural, traditions, gender, sexuality or socioeconomic factors at play in the book? If so, what? How did it effect the characters?
15. In a movie version, who would play Enid and the other characters?
16. If you could write another chapter to the end of the book, what would happen?
